DISBURSEMENTS

<u>Discussion</u> – The association's treasurer did not prepare a report on disbursements as none had taken place since the last meeting.

2017-2018 BUDGET

<u>Discussion</u> – The Treasurer presented a budget proposal for the 2017-2018 season that can be found at Annex A to these minutes. Highlights of the proposal include:

- Donations and sponsorships netted \$12,800 last year and remains the same for the upcoming season;
- Food netted \$830 last year and this amount will be increased to \$1,500 based on input from the Parent Rep Purchasing.
- Fundraising revenues will be increased significantly as a result of the fundraising cheque collected as part of registration for this season.
- The budget for equipment and jerseys was increased slightly.
- The amount budgeted for teams to participate in tournaments was increased.

The proposal generated significant discussion regarding the value of allocating so much of the budget to pay for teams to attend tournaments out of town. Several members argued that tournaments have limited development value for players and that more of the budget should be dedicated instead to funding activities that add meaningful ice time for the players at all levels. A number of members suggested that the amount allocated to fund away tournaments be limited to what is fundraised at events such as the golf tournament. However, given the lower-than-expected registrations for the golf tournament, several members felt that it would be unfair to reduce the amount budgeted to fund away tournaments without prior warning to the membership. A compromise was eventually reached that included a separate motion (see Res. #17-07-06) but this discussion will be added to the next AGM in order to ensure that matter is handled in accordance with the preference of the whole membership.

FUNDRAISING UPDATE

<u>Discussion</u> – As of the date of the meeting, only 38 people were registered to play in the annual golf tournament. Flyers are out and the event is being advertised on the radio. Prizes are still coming in. The Fundraising committee chairperson requested permission to put an ad in the newspaper and the Treasurer stated that the budget that has been voted earlier in the meeting includes provision for advertising, so this is something that she can handle on her own. The Fundraising Committee Chairperson stated that organizing an event such as this is a lot of work for very little return given the lack of interest and that we should review the need to hold this event in the future. Without at least 72 players in the tournament, it is not worth the time and effort it takes to organize. The Chairperson also requested that all Executive Committee members actively promote the tournament, including selling tickets to friends and family.

REGISTRATION UPDATE

<u>Discussion</u> – There are currently 260 players registered, including 53x CHIPs, 17x Tykes, 34x Novices, 39x Atoms, 46x Peewees, 37x Bantams, and 30x Midgets. The website will be updated to inform everyone that limited spots are still available in the Tyke, Atom, Peewee, Bantam, and Midget divisions but that the CHIP and Novice divisions are full.

ABUSE & HARASSMENT COMMITTEE

<u>Discussion</u> – The President informed the rest of the Executive Committee that he had not yet met with the members of the Abuse and Harassment Committee in place for last season and that this agenda item will therefore have to be moved to a future meeting.

ROUND TABLE

<u>Coach Liaison</u> – The Coach Liaison stated that he had attended the clinics on the Friday before the OMHA AGM in June and provided the Executive Committee members with an overview of what he had learned. Highlights include the Lacing Up program that is a cross-ice development program but won't change what we had been doing already in Wasaga Beach. There was some discussion around the Novice program going cross-ice eventually, but it is not yet the case for the foreseeable future.

<u>Silver Stick Director</u> – The 2017-2018 Picture Night will be on October 25th and 26th and it is important that the supplier update our logo.

Notes to Year End Financial Report - Income Statement (I/S):

1. The Budget for registration revenues was estimated based on previous year registrations at the time of budget preparation. WBMH increase in

2. Door revenues are collected during the regular season and playoffs. Referee expenses are paid from the monies collected at the door.

3. The food revenues (net of expenses) include the kitchen rental fee of \$45.00 plus HST per day for Silverstick and Local League Tournaments.

4. The fundraising events for 2016/2017 included, although not limited to, a Tag Day, Golf Tournament, Barrie Colts night. Tag Day and the Golf

5. Silverstick Revenues are down as a result of the initial cancellation of the Bantam and Midget tournament. However, the rescheduled tournament

6. This account is used to pay for a cashier to collect door revenues, and pay referees. WBMH executive approved an increase to fees paid during the

7. The expenses included in this account are, but not limited to, the purchase of new performance socks, pucks, storage bins, bags, jerseys and sponsorship

This account includes all fees paid for all meetings held In the arena hall (excluding tournaments).
The majority of the amount in the account includes OMHA annual insurance expenses.

10. The Team Tournament money was tentatively budgeted at ~\$400/team. During the year the executive approved that all future team tournament

WBMH Bike Lottery income, is held in trust to be used for activities (additional ice, training, clinics) above and beyond normal operating requirements

13. The Executive has approved an annual allocation of Jersey Expenses to be carry forward until replacement of Jerseys are necessary.
